

1. GSWPGA Tournament lower participation rate in 2025

Summary:

- Discussion regarding lower participation in the 2025 tournament season, exploring possible causes, challenges faced, and potential strategies to increase engagement next season.
 - Wendy polled a number of participants to see if there was any negative feedback regarding the tournaments and the mixing of handicaps on the tee sheet. No negative feedback was received; however, some players expressed a preference to play with competitors of similar handicaps.
 - Several participants noted that communication from the City Representative to the club could be improved. Often the club was not aware of the upcoming tournament schedule, and by the time they were informed, it was too late to adjust due to scheduling conflicts.
 - A survey will be sent out to members to solicit input on the participation or lack thereof. Sariya will be coordinating this. Other ideas to encourage participation included a one-time waiver of the entry fee; increase engagement with City Reps; increase website usage with tournament information; incentives for both clubs and players
