

Summary:

- Margot kicked off the meeting with attendees introducing themselves and their role with the GSWPGA. At the General Meeting in February, there will be a vote to officially install the officers. There was discussion about the Trustee as it is usually the past president that serves in this capacity. However, given Wendy Gapp's considerable involvement and knowledge of the organization, there was general consensus to ask her to serve as Trustee for 2026. Kathy Elmendorf moved to nominate Wendy as Trustee; the motion was seconded by Deborah Le Cuyer and the motion was passed unanimously. As with the other officers, a vote will be held at the General Meeting in February to confirm the position.
- The role of the assistant treasurer was also discussed, as Deborah Le Cuyer and Colleen Donovan have agreed to share the Treasury duties for 2026. Following the meeting, Margot reviewed the by-laws and the position of an assistant treasurer is provided for in the GSWPGA by-laws. The by-laws

also require an audit when there is a change of Treasurer. Although Deborah will stay on in a supporting role, Margo will ask D. Shores if she is willing to perform an audit of the GSWPGA books.

Treasurer Report

The annual dues are due and payable by the February General Meeting. Beth will send a notice to each club. Dues are unchanged from the prior year at \$45 and \$45 for clubs participating in Team events. Deborah will send Beth details for Zelle and Venmo payments.

Deborah and Colleen have transitioned the accounting for GSWPGA from Quickbooks to Zoho. Quickbooks was very dated and slow. Zoho is web-based and will allow both individuals to access account information. The current balance in the account is \$4833.77. Deborah confirmed that the account is balanced and everything is in good order. There are 3 boxes of archived records with bank account information and treasury records. The by-laws will be reviewed to determine how long these records should be retained.

Secretary Report



The survey was developed to gain further insight into the lower tournament participation rate in 2025. Sariya will be working on the website to give it a cleaner look and feel. There was a brief discussion about including online tournament registration, but it was agreed that it should remain with the individual clubs.

Social – Rebecca Early Rebecca is already in the planning stages for the end of year luncheon for GSWPGA. She suggested a name change – instead of “Trophy”, perhaps “End of Year Celebration”.
